Over the years, the company has been responsible for a wide-range of projects, from the polar bear exhibit at the N.C. Zoo in Asheboro, N.C. to the complete renovation of the iconic Grove Park Inn in Asheville, N.C.

At the Holiday Inn-Airport Conference Center Hotel, Hendrick Construction joined forces with the owner, Atma Hotel Group, to complete a \$7 million state-of-the-art renovation. Guest rooms, the lobby, restaurant, bar, more than 5,000 square feet of meeting

space, as well as exterior renovations including the building facade, parking lot and landscaping are all fresh and new.

Hendrick Construction built Home2 Suites by Hilton adjacent to Charlotte Douglas Airport from the ground up. The 107-suite hotel designed for both business and leisure travelers celebrated its grand opening this summer.

"From renovating existing facilities while maintaining positive guest experiences to coordinating with the FAA and airport on a site that is directly in line with the flight path, we welcome any challenge."
